SALT LAKE PLANNING COMMISSION:

Negative Recommendation for Clift Infill Project

The application to amend the Northwest Master Plan to allow a higher density housing project on the inner-block south of Backman Elementary, the Clift Infill Project, received a negative recommendation from the Planning Commission at its January 8th meeting. The application to amend, with the negative recommendation, was submitted to the City Council last week. The City Council's action on the issue will be forthcoming in the coming weeks. The Council meets on Tuesdays, with their agendas being released on the preceding Friday. So stay tuned.

The Fairpark Community Council has strongly opposed this application, both in its original plan to

build 32 single-family residences on 3-acre area and the modified version to build 12 residences on a smaller 1-acre area.

Currently, this area (as is almost all of the Fairpark Community) is classified in the Master Plan as low-density single-family residences on lots no smaller than 7,000 square feet. If the application to amend is approved by the City Council, the developers will be permitted to build residences on 2,000 square foot lots.
